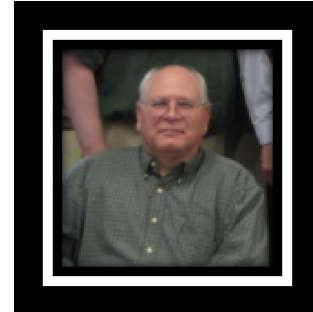




Kay Dix Monroe, CPA
