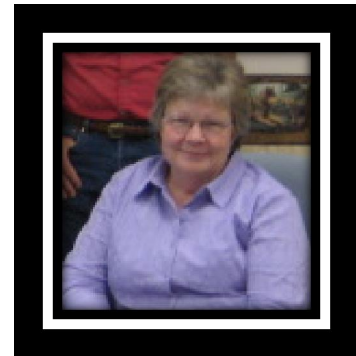




Marsha L. Chappell
